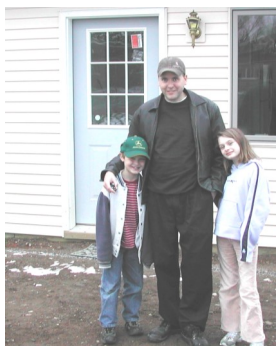


Why a Legacy Society?

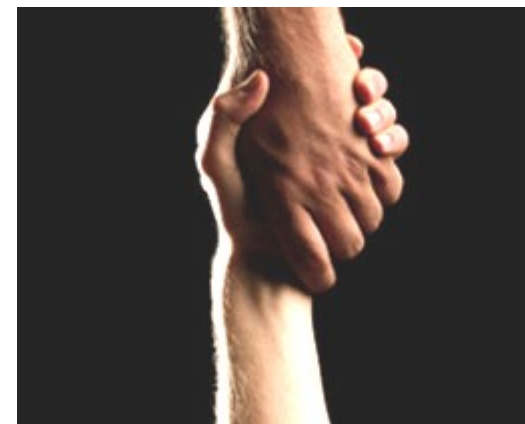
